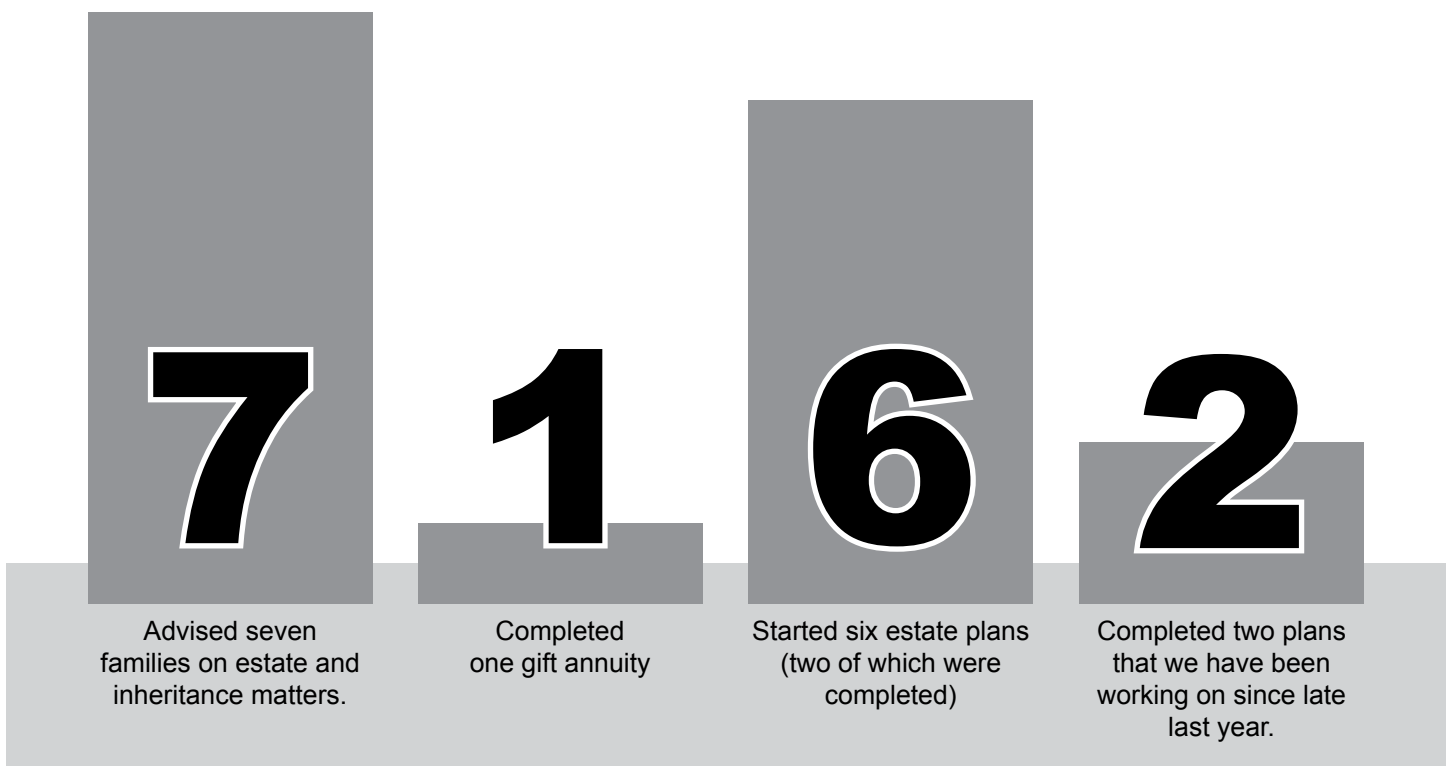


ASSOCIATE FOR BIBLICAL STEWARDSHIP
